68th ANNUAL CONNECTICUT ARTISTS EXHIBITION
February 19 through March 30, 2012

Artist's signature constitutes acceptance of all site conditions and liability.

- ELIGIBILITY** Resident artists of Connecticut - **no work previously exhibited at the SMM in any show is eligible.**
- MEDIA** Paintings, drawings, mixed media, sculpture, and graphics including photography.
- ENTRY** Two entries per artist. ALL WORK MUST BE READY TO INSTALL. Two dimensional works must be framed, glazed, screw eyes/wire - multi-part works must be assembled as one unit. No work greater than 60 inches in any dimension. **Maximum weight:** Two-dimensional 80 lbs - Three dimensional 150 lbs. The SMM staff reserve the right to remove from consideration any object that does not meet these criteria. The Museum Director may override any selection made by the juror.
- ENTRY FEE** \$15 for the first entry, \$10 for the second entry. Checks payable to the **Slater Memorial Museum**. Friends of the Slater Museum may submit first entry free of charge. **Fees are not refundable.**
- DELIVERY** Entries will be received at the Converse Art Gallery (adjacent to and to the rear of the SMM, enter through new glass doors under arch on south side of building and follow signs) on Saturday and Sunday, February 4 and 5 from 1 pm to 4 pm. Attach entry cards to each object on the upper left back. **IMPORTANT - Do not ship or bring entries during unspecified hours.**
- NOTIFICATION** Judging will take place Monday, February 6, 2012, weather permitting. **Artists will receive the self-addressed accepted/declined cards via first class mail immediately following the judging. PLEASE DO NOT PHONE THE MUSEUM.**
- Declined work** may be collected on Friday, February 10 from 8:30 am - 3:30 pm: Saturday and Sunday, February 11 & 12 from 1 pm - 3:30 pm. All declined work must be collected at these dates/times at the MAIN RECEPTION DESK of the museum. A \$5 per day late fee will be charged thereafter.
- Accepted work** will be displayed in the Converse Gallery until Friday, March 30, 2012. Displayed works must be collected Saturday, March 31 or Sunday, April 1, from 1 pm - 3:30 pm or Monday, April 2, from 8:30 am - 3:30 pm at the MAIN RECEPTION DESK. **A \$5 per day late fee will be charged thereafter.**
- SELECTION** Jeffrey Andersen is the Director of the Florence Griswold Museum, where he has served for 35 years. A native of Northern California, Andersen holds an M.A. in Museum Studies from Cooperstown Graduate Program (SUNY-Oneonta), Cooperstown, New York and a B.A. in History from Lewis and Clark College, Portland, Oregon. Under Mr. Andersen's direction, the Florence Griswold Museum has evolved from a seasonal attraction with visitation of fewer than 1,000 per year to a year-round National Historic Landmark Museum with a staff of 17 and visitation of over 60,000 annually. Mr. Andersen has organized numerous exhibitions and authored publications on the Lyme Art Colony and the arts of Connecticut.
- AWARDS AND RECEPTION** Up to \$950 will be awarded in prizes. Through a special grant from the Katherine Forest Crafts Foundation, a special one-time award for excellence in textile art will be conferred. Honorable mentions may also be awarded. Award winners will be announced at 2 pm during the exhibition opening reception on Sunday, February 26, 2012 from 1 - 3 pm.
- SALES AND PUBLICITY** Sales handled through the SMM will be subject to a 20% convenience fee. Artists agree to allow the SMM to reproduce and/or publish artwork for exhibit publicity and promotional purposes, unless written refusal is submitted.
- LIABILITY** All entries will receive careful handling by competent staff; however, the Slater Memorial Museum, or anyone connected with this exhibition, cannot be held responsible for the loss or damage to any entry submitted and received subject to this condition.
- DIRECTIONS** Traveling East on Route 2, turn right at the traffic light at Washington Street. Continue on Rte. 2 East and turn left at the traffic light at Chelsea Parade. Traveling west on Route 2, drive through downtown Norwich, and turn right at the light at Chelsea Parade. The Slater Memorial Museum is on the campus of the Norwich Free Academy.
